Title: Sr. Azure Engineer/Architect

Purpose: To engineer and build solutions in public cloud IaaS platforms (Azure). To plan migrations from private hosted infrastructure, to cloud or hybrid solutions. To support a mission critical infrastructure and ensure the highest levels of availability, performance, and security.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Act as a subject matter expert at Neovera for Azure's Infrastructure as a Service;
- Plan and execute large-scale migrations of systems from private infrastructure to public cloud platforms (particularly Azure and AWS);
- Work with monitoring tools; manage access and permissions; script and automate where possible; maintain appropriate configurations; provide recommendations on system improvements;
- Build scalable enterprise solutions using Azure's IaaS offering, and, where appropriate, using services directly from Azure's PaaS suite;
- Deploy, maintain, and troubleshoot servers and services in our private cloud (vSphere) infrastructure and in customer Microsoft Azure tenants;
- Support applications that run on Windows Server operating systems;
- Manage Microsoft Active Directory domain environment and typical services, including administration of users and groups, DNS, DHCP, Group Policy, DFS, ADFS, LDAP and Windows Workstations as they pertain to an enterprise AD environment;
- Maintain secure environments running in Azure using industry-accepted standards (MFA, encrypted data transfer, etc.);
- Manage and automate enterprise-wide server and desktop systems patching for OS and standard applications;
- Maintain and support backups and replication;
- Monitor server performance and troubleshoot problem areas as needed;
- Work closely with other Neovera engineers of other disciplines for escalation support and system interoperability;
- Work with hardware, software, and service vendors/partners to assist in troubleshooting systems as necessary;
- Perform other duties as required.

Qualifications:

- 5 to 7+ years of relevant work experience managing an Active Directory Domain, Windows Servers, VMware vSphere infrastructure, and other mission critical enterprise level systems;
- Experience working with virtual machines, virtual networking and storage in Azure Infrastructure as a Service;

- A pro-active mind-set with a focus on constant improvement and follow through at all levels;
- Strong technical problem-solving skills;
- In depth knowledge of the Microsoft IaaS products (ARM, Storage accounts, virtual machines, security and encryption, BC/DR, monitoring);
- Familiar with changes necessary to maintain performance levels of applications when transitioning from on-premise environments to IaaS public clouds;
- Ability to take ownership of issues, work independently or escalate as needed, and find creative ways to resolve problems;
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills with the ability to clearly, and concisely present complicated technical concepts to end-users with differing skill levels.
